

There are two trails: the Motoyama Course from the former Toyoha Mine and the Usubetsu Course, which continues from the Horaizawa forest trail. By following the ridge road where both courses meet, you will reach the highest point (elevation: 1,464m), but there is no view from there so the "real summit" is at a triangulation point 250m further down the trail (elevation: 1,460.2m). There is a wide area there with a view of Mt. Yotei and the various mountains that surround Sapporo.





- ►Trailhead: Horai Hut (Usubetsu course) / Mt. Muine lodge ruins (Motoyama course)
- **▶**Climbing Ascent: approx. 3 hours and 30 minutes Time Descent: approx. 2 hours and 40 minutes
- ▶ Toilet: At the side of Muineshiri hut on the Usubetsu course
- ▶Cell phone: Trailhead 🛜 , Summit 🕏

- ▶ The second gate of the Horaizawa forest trail is permanently closed. You will have to walk from there to the trailhead
- ▶ Check with Hokkaido University Academic Affairs Department for the opening days and hours of the Muineshiri hut.
- ▶ The wooden footpath is slippery and there are unsteady areas, so watch your step.
- ▶ Please note that there are areas where you will have to climb and descend from a steep ladder.
